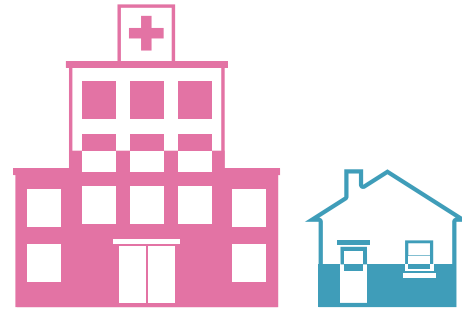
“The biggest problem is that there are **not enough Midwives**, in not enough places in the **province**...”²

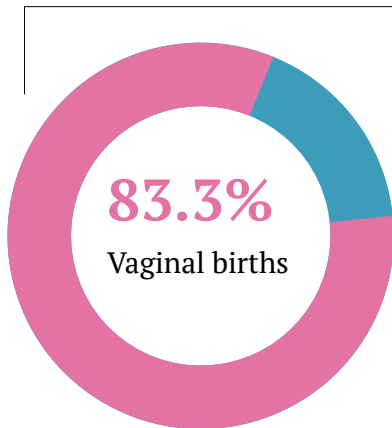


Horizon's Fredericton **Midwifery Centre** is the first and only one in New Brunswick, established in 2017

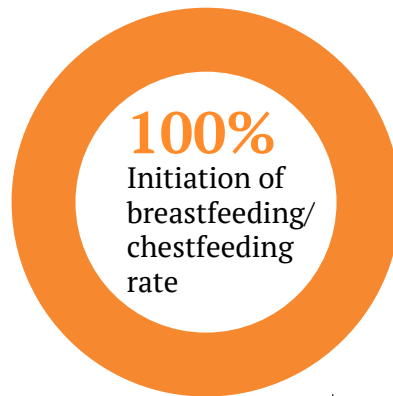
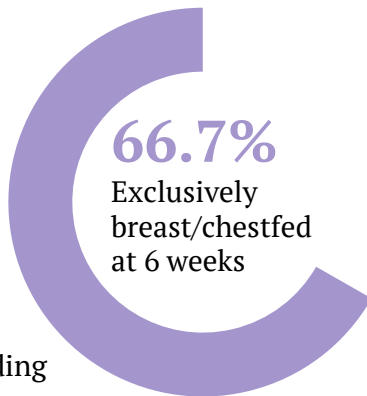
