Policy: Clinical Midwifery Experience Requirements for Initial Registration

In addition to the requirements for registration as set in the regulations of the *Midwifery Act (O.C. 2010-461)*, each applicant must have specific clinical experience in midwifery practice prior to the date of application for registration.

The clinical midwifery requirements for all applicants are:

Attendance at a minimum of **60** births, of which

- A. **40** were attended as primary midwife,
- B. **30** were attended as part of the care provided to a client in accordance with the principles of continuity of care
- C. **10** were attended in hospital, of which at least five were attended as primary midwife, and
- D. **10** were attended in a residence or remote clinic or remote birth centre, of which at least five were attended as primary midwife.

All of the above experience must have been in the last **5** years.
