Application and Approval Process for Second Attendants

The health care professional applying for second attendant approval must fully complete the prescribed application form and provide the Midwifery Council of New Brunswick (MCNB) with the following information.

Incomplete applications will not be processed by MCNB.

All second attendant applicants will provide the MCNB with the following:

- Their health regulatory body membership registration number and a photocopy of their current registration card/certificate;
- Verification of current Neonatal Resuscitation Program certification (NRP) within last 12 months (i.e. photocopy of most recent certificate/card);
- Verification of current Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation certification for Health Care Providers in compliance with the current professional and community health care standards (photocopy of most recent certificate/card);
- Confirmation that the applicant has undergone a criminal record and vulnerable sector check within the last five years;
- Confirmation of current or recent health care experience
- Successful completion of MCNB's approved "Second Attendant Home Birth Training";
- Receipt of MCNB Application Fee.
